VINTAGE 2010.

Selected bunches of premium Shiraz grapes from our Dennistone Vineyard were handpicked on 17th March 2010, destemmed and fermented in open vats for 9 days, basket pressed, with malolactic fermentation in French oak barriques for 83 days. This 2010 HARTZ BARN WINES Barossa General Store Shiraz wine was raked and returned to French oak barrique barrels and American oak barrels to complete barrel maturation before bottling on 26th June 2012

TASTING NOTE.

Bouquet notes of chocolate, blackberry, pepper, spice and leather blend with the smooth velvety tannins to deliver the wonderful mouth feel of this balanced Barossa General Store Reserve Shiraz wine of distinction to enjoy with good food, family and friends.
